Pope Martin was elected Pope in 649.

At the time there existed a belief that Jesus only had a a divine will and not a a human will.

The emperor at the time issued an edict that no one could discuss the issue of divine versus human will.

This edict was condemned by a council convened by Martin.

In response the emperor sent soldiers to Rome the Pope was taken and imprisoned .

He was convicted of treason and exiled to Crimea where he died in 656.
